Recycle your stamps: Please recycle your stamps (allowing a border of 8mm/1/4in when cutting from an envelope) and place them in the wicker basket in the front vestibule of the church (QSE) or the bags at the front door of the church and in the hall (BSM)

Recycle your printer toners and cartridges: boxes at BSM and QSE church doors.

Recycle your spectacles: Have you old spectacles which you no longer require? Hand them into the church office.

Recycle white plastic milk jug tops in the box in the vestibule of the large hall at QSE. These are taken to a collection point in the Borders and sold on to make sleeving for electrical cables. They have raised £16,000 towards palliative and cancer care in the Borders area.
